

Acton Turville Parish Council Privacy and Cookie policy

Web site Privacy

We are committed to safeguarding the privacy of our web site visitors; this policy sets out how we will treat your personal information.

Acton Turville Parish Council does not collect, store or use any personal information arising from the use of its web site.

What information do we collect on our website?

The content of the Acton Turville Parish Council web site is maintained by the Council. The operation of the web site is carried out by a third party, WEBS, who have their own Privacy Policy which can be viewed at <https://www.webs.com/terms-of-service#privacy>

WEBS may collect, store and use any information that is collected in the following ways:

1. information about your computer and about your visits to and use of this website (including your IP address, geographical location, browser type, referral source, length of visit and number of page views)
2. any other information that you choose to send to us

Acton Turville Parish Council has access to aggregated and anonymised information relating to the number of web pages visited each day.

Cookies

A cookie consists of information sent by a web server to a web browser and stored by the browser. The information is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server. This enables the web server to identify and track the web browser. Cookies can identify users, remember preferences, and help users complete tasks without having to re-enter information when visiting multiple pages or returning to your site. This helps provide a more personalised and slick user experience.

By using our website you are consenting to the use of cookies.

Both “session” cookies and “persistent” cookies may be used on the website. Session cookies can be used to keep track of you whilst you navigate the website. Persistent cookies can be used to enable our website to recognise you when you visit.

Session cookies will be deleted from your computer when you close your browser. Persistent cookies will remain stored on your computer until deleted, or until they reach a specified expiry date.

Like most websites, this site uses Analytics to track user interaction. This is used to determine the number of people using our site, to better understand how they find and use our web pages and to see their journey through the website.

Although WEBS Analytics records data such as your geographical location, device, internet browser and operating system, none of this information personally identifies you to

us. WEBS Analytics also records your computer's IP address which could be used to personally identify you but WEBS do not grant the Acton Turville Parish Council access to this. We consider WEBS to be a third party data processor.

Most browsers allow you to refuse to accept cookies. This will, however, have a negative impact upon the usability of many websites.
